

Resuming all the activities of the school

In resuming the school's activities on 4th January for the year 2021, the school was able to cover the first term activities and the lesson plans as scheduled successfully. Students' attendance marked around 30 to 40 percent due to the pandemic situation at the beginning. Although, the attendance came to good position by the mid of February, and it always could be managed around 90 percent attendance in every class room by end of the term.

The school maintained a regular health attitude of the staff and students of the school in following government's health guidelines accordingly in keeping the distance, wearing mask, checking body temperature, washing hands and disinfection the school premises. The school could maintain the term successfully without any Covid-19 infection from the school up to now.

Several Health awareness sessions also were organized for children and school staff for the purpose of improving better health habits and to aware how to prevent from the Covid-19 with the support of Public Health Office of the division.

Unexpectedly, the 3rd wave of the COVID-19 hit again to all the sectors of the country badly. The school had to close again from 03rd May as the government issuing restriction for the second time.

Referring to the continuous school closures, after a week later, all teachers of the school gathered to discuss to take steps to continue the lessons plans for the second term using ONLINE method. Teachers agreed to continue the relevant lesson plans through ONLINE for all groups. Several teachers suggested to use different APPs like ZOOM, WEBEx, and MS TEAM. Finally all came to a single decision to use ZOOM app, because it gives much facilities and it can be used as a FREE version for a limited people. At the first stage, teachers agreed to do in staying their home using own facilities.

1st term (Jan-Apr) activities of year 2021

04th January 2021: The general meeting for the year 2020 was held for all the staff members of the school. The chief directress, The manager and the coordinators also added their views at the meeting.



06th January 2021: The orientation of the new intake of the pre-school was held for the new admission 2021. 80 applicants participated for the orientation and Principal, pre-school coordinator made and awareness the parents of the children on the programs which have been scheduled to be commenced and how the activities and lessons are arranged for the year.



07th January 2021: The orientation of the vocational training for the new admission 2021 of computer, English, Tamil, photography and Women Cooperation. 250 applicants participated for the meeting and Principal, School coordinator and unit coordinators made the participants aware of the courses and the programs which are scheduled to be commenced for the first term.



11th January 2021: The COVID-19 delayed most examinations of several batches of 2020 who had completed the course of English and Computer. However, after a 6 months late, we were allowed to hold their final examinations for limited persons in different time slots and arranged to conduct for other groups gradually. One of the group appeared their final examination.





04th February 2021: Sri Lanka proudly celebrated her 72nd independence day. The one world college also marked the importance of the day with the participation of all the school community of the school.



08-February 2021: 72 pre-schoolers of the pre-school batch 2019-2020, passed out from the school in completing their two years early childhood education and received their certificates from the chief directors Prof: Kathrin Messner. The Principal, the Manager and all the pre-schol teachers and parents participated in this simple event. The batch also was to be completed their studies by the year 2020. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation this batch also was to extended till February in 2021 and continued another two months.



15-March 2021: 150,000 worth school exercise books which were received as a special donation from Mr. Sarith Fernando who is a member of a catholic charity organization in Colombo, were distributed among all the children of the school. It was a big help for our children because many of children struggle in taking their school needs due impact o COVID-19 pandemic situation.



18-March 2021: Five children received special award from the chief dicrector prof. Kathrin Messner at a specail event which was held on the day, as the five students successfully scored around 180 marks out of 200 and passed the Grade V Scholarship examination which was held in 2020. and They were qualified enter for national schools in the island.





30th March 2021. 12th Death Anniversary of the founder director of the one world foundation Hon. Joseph Ortner was held with the participation of all the community of the school. All honored and respected by remembering on his great service what he introduced for the benefit of under privileged children of the country.



2nd April 2021- The inter cricket tournament of the batch January 2021 was organized by the vocational training unit of the school to mark the Sinhala & Tamil new year celebration. Computer, English, WC and the Teaching Staff participated in the tournament. The teaching staff team won the trophy by defeating all the other teams in the tournament.



6th April 2021- 200 hundreds certificates were distributed among the students who successfully completed the courses of Computer, English, Tamil and Photography which conducted during the year 2020. The Chief director Prof: Kathrin Messner was the chief invitee to the event as well as the manager of the one world foundation, the principal, the school coordinator and the teachers of the unit participated in the event. 200 hundred of trainees were qualified to National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) level 2, 3 and 4.



9th April 2021- Pre-school unit of the school organized a simple event to mark the Sinhala & Tamil new year festivity in the school premises. The objective of the event was to aware the children on Sinhala & Tamil cultural values which have been lasted since many centuries between both Sinhala and Tamil community.



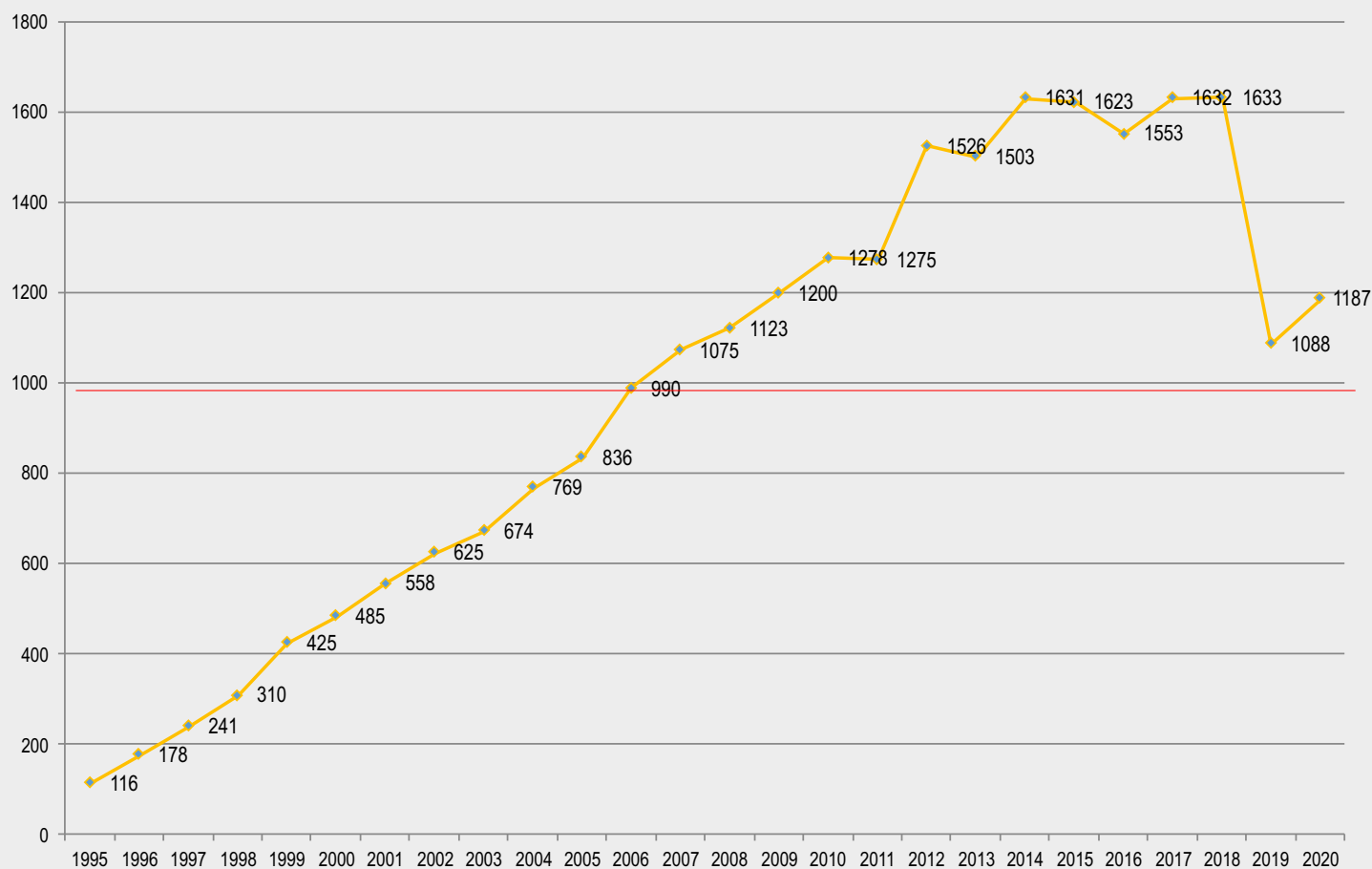


In short, 25 years history of the school

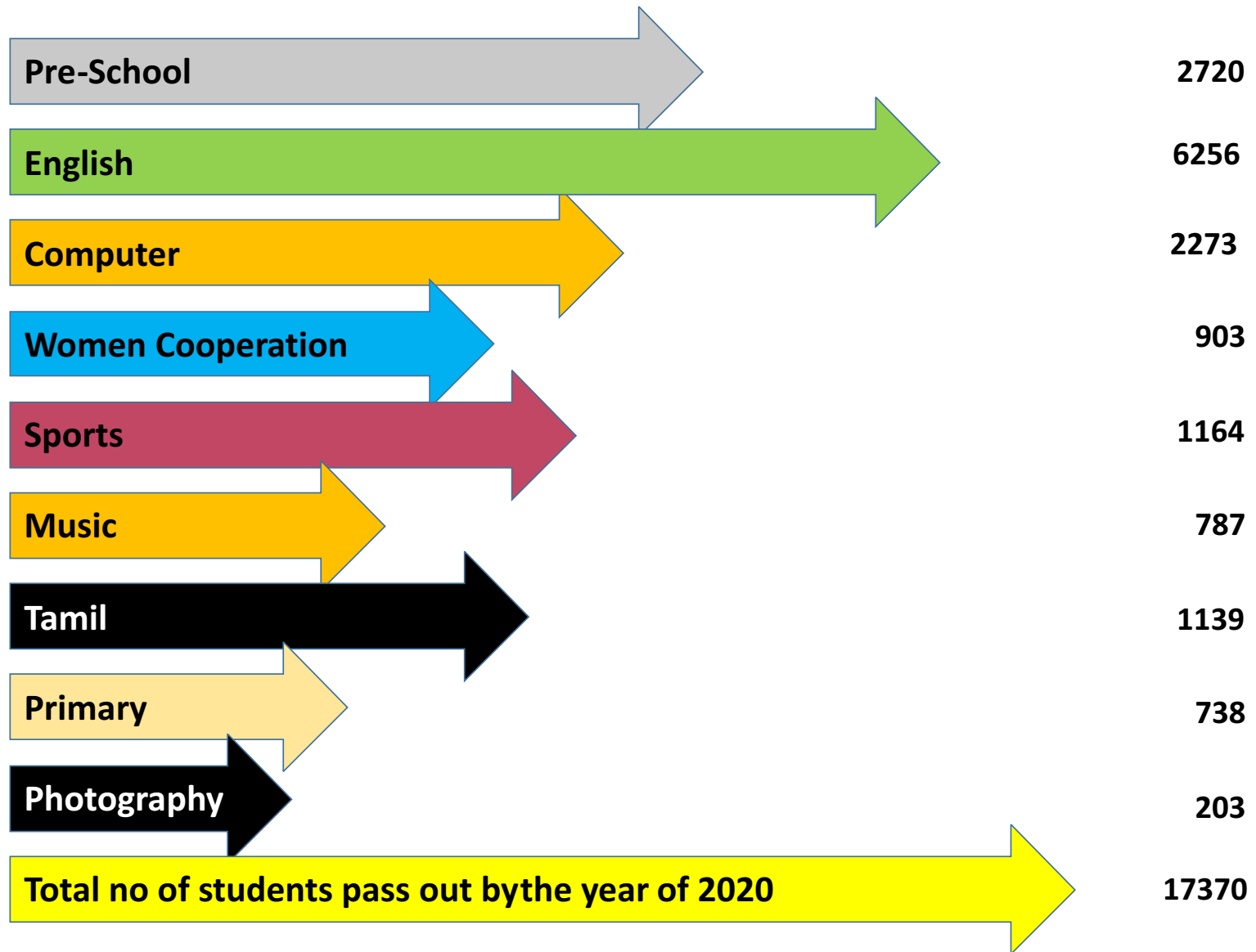
